ELIGIBILITY

Only girls enrolled in the 6^{th} , 7^{th} , and 8^{th} grade will be eligible to compete in the open girls tournament.

All open girls entries not entered by a school, MUST be prepared to provide a document of proof of current grade enrollment in a school in **Arizona; home-schooled girls must provide proof of domicile in the state of Arizona

ENTRIES

Pre-registration is strongly encouraged! Entries can be submitted via the Track Wrestling Registration site. A direct link will be provided on our website and in this document after January 1, 2025.

ALL pre-registration entries are due on Monday, January 27th at midnight. Onsite entries will be accepted the day of the tournament at a higher fee (\$45). We reserve the right to limit entries to 16 per weight class so register now!

Wrestling starts at approx. 11 am and runs concurrently with the school side **TIMES**

WEIGH-INS Saturday, February 1st (on the mats) from 8:00-9:00 am (with school side)

All wrestlers must weigh-in wearing their competition uniform

1-2-2 **PERIOD** Championship rounds: Consolation rounds: 1-1-1 TIMES

This is a double-elimination tournament; all wrestlers are guaranteed 2 matches

Wrestlers will be separated by school/club. Beyond that, we plan to seed **SEEDING**

> wrestlers based on the information we have available to us, including their 2024-2025 record as well as last year's Copper State Championships placement. Any and all information wrestlers, coaches, and/or parents can provide for potential seeds would be appreciated. We will especially lean on 2025 Tempe and other

major tournament (Tulsa) results.

We reserve the right to condense weight classes in the event we have fewer than

four (4) entries in a weight class.

TRAINER Certified medical staff will be present at the tournament

SNACK BAR Various food stands will be operating during the tournament, inside the venue,

none of which are associated with the tournament but are independently

operated. We are terribly sorry but a hospitality room is not allowed at the FTC

due to their contract with food vendors.

FINALS (Saturday, $\approx 5:00$ pm): 1^{st} through 4^{th} place matches (2 mats)

Order of the finals will be determined by selecting at random, the weight class to be conducted first and then proceeding sequentially from that weight class (e.g.,

94 is drawn, it will be the first weight class wrestled, then 102, 110, etc....)

LODGING Lodging is closely available in the Prescott area and you are encouraged to make

reservations ASAP!

UNIFORMS All wrestlers must compete in an appropriate wrestling uniform (singlet,

compression shorts and fight shirt, etc...). Wrestlers MUST wear wrestling shoes

and headgear.
